

B. AGREEMENT DESCRIPTION AND SCHEDULE OF SERVICES

B.1 DESCRIPTION OF AGREEMENT

B.1.1 The contractor shall furnish to the Government the vehicle storage facilities needed to effect the storage of Privately Owned Vehicles (POVs) of military members in accordance with the specifications listed in this contract for the period of 15 Mar 1998 through 14 Mar 2003, the expiration date, unless sooner terminated under the terms of this contract.

B.1.2 The Government estimates the annual sustained vehicle storage volume to be but not limited to 125 vehicles, 100 in Area I and 25 in Area II (see B.1.3).

B.1.2.1 A pre-award facility inspection will be accomplished to ensure all requirements of Technical Exhibit 12 (Pre-Award Facility Checklist) are met. Any item identified by the Government Inspector as a "No" will disqualify a contractor for award of a BPA.

B.1.3 Agreements will be awarded to multiple contractors to ensure enough capacity is available to service all customers within the San Antonio, Austin, and Houston area. Areas of service are divided among the following counties within Texas:

Area I - San Antonio and Austin - Includes counties of Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Blanco, Bastrop, Caldwell, Comal, Dewitt, Duval, Fayette, Frio, Gillespie, Gonzales, Guadalupe, Hays, Jim Hogg, Karnes, Kendall, Kerr, La Salle, Lavaca, McMullen, Medina, Travis, Williamson, Wilson, Webb, and Zapata.

Area II - Houston - Includes counties of Austin, Brazoria, Brazos, Burleson, Chambers, Colorado, Fort Bend, Galveston, Grimes, Hardin, Harris, Houston, Jackson, Jefferson, Lee, Leon, Liberty, Madison, Matagorda, Milam, Montgomery, Polk, Robertson, San Jacinto, Trinity, Tyler, Walker, Waller, Washington, and Wharton.

B.1.4 The Contracting Officer may extend the BPA ordering period annually but cannot exceed a total of four (4) years.

B.1.5 The combined annual estimated number of POVs for the San Antonio area is 100 vehicles for Brooks Air Force Base, Lackland Air Force Base, Kelly Air Force Base, Ft Sam Houston Army Installation, Randolph Air Force Base, and the greater Austin area. The combined annual estimated number of POVs for the Houston area is 25 vehicles for Ellington Air National Guard Base and the greater Houston area.

B. 2 EXTENT OF OBLIGATION

B.2.1 The Government intends to award a Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA). The BPA itself is not a contract. Contracts will be awarded by issuance and acceptance of service orders as stated in the requirements. Within the BPA, several clauses refer to this instrument as a "contract" and do so because each clause is incorporated upon acceptance of each service order. This BPA does not require the Government to use the BPA unless it is in the Government's best interest to do so. The Government does not guarantee that the contractor will receive any contracts under this BPA.

B.2.2 The bid items identified below are inclusive and are a single factor bid price for all services ordered by way of this agreement. You may bid on one or both areas; however, you must have storage facilities located in the areas for which you bid. All prices should be submitted based on F.O.B. origin; in other words, the Government will deliver

the vehicle to contractor facilities. If the contractor submits additional prices based on F.O.B destination or other (contractor offering to pick-up vehicle at site other than its own facilities), then that price must be clearly marked as such.

B.3 PURCHASE LIMITATION

B.3.1 Individual service orders issued by individuals authorized shall not exceed the micropurchase threshold, currently \$2,500.00, without contracting officer approval.

B.3.2 Contractor will receive a notice from the contracting officer which will include a list of individuals authorized to purchase under the BPA, identified either by title of position or by name of individual, organizational component, and the dollar limitation per purchase for each position title or individual.
